TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES*

Sec. 56-1. Traffic control signs and signals.

Traffic-control signals and signs shall be installed at locations identified by the town board and enumerated by ordinance from time to time.

Sec. 56-2. Parking regulations.

The board may establish, from time to time by ordinance, regulations concerning the permissible locations, time periods, and exceptions concerning parking. Violations shall be punished in accordance with the general penalty provision of this Code.

Sec. 56-3. Speed limits and zones.

The board may establish, from time to time by ordinance, regulations setting forth speed limits and speed zones on public roads.

SECTION I. BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Councilmen of the Village of Fenton, Inc. this 6th day of July, 1971, that it be unlawful for aircraft to fly lower than five hundred (500) feet of said village.

SECTION II. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that aircraft spraying, dusting, or fogging in the vicinity are prohibited from performing such activities in such manner that said spraying, dusting,

or fogging will any way damage fruit trees, gardens, and other foliage within the Village.
